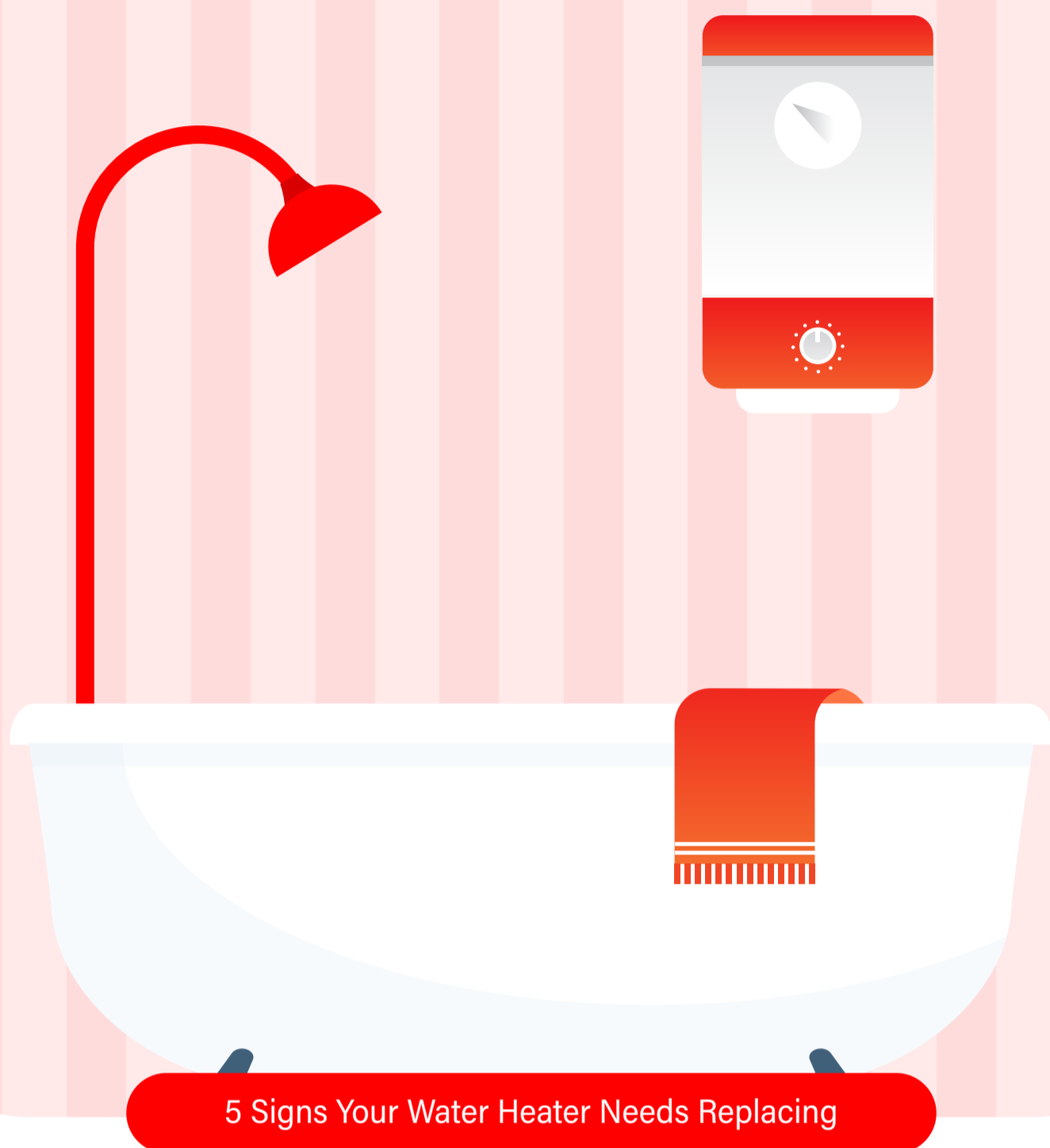

5 Signs Your Water Heater Needs Replacing

Age of the Heater

Understanding the age of your tankless water heater in Petaluma, CA, helps give a rough idea of when your system needs replacements. Most home water heaters have a life expectancy of between 8 to 12 years. If your water heater has stayed this long, it might be time for water heater replacement.



High Utility Bills

If you're increasing your gas bill by using more energy to provide the same amount of hot water, your unit may need to be looked at by professionals. In some cases, this may mean that you are forced to replace the unit if the problem isn't resolved with simple water heater repairs.



Change in Water Quality

Several things can affect your water's quality. And if the quality is poor, it may be a sign that something is wrong with your tankless water heater. If you notice rusty, cloudy, or dirty water, it might be time to get a new tankless gas water heater.



Regular Water Heater Repair

If you're having the same type of water heater repairs done over and over again, chances are there's a deeper problem in your system. Replacing your entire system will be much cheaper than constantly paying for repairs.



Loss of Efficiency

A water heater should be able to provide sufficient hot water when you need it. If the system is not doing its job, it will need to be inspected right away. Unfortunately, in most cases, this is an indication of a worn out tankless water heater that needs replacing.
